



NOTICE OF ROADWORKS SLOPE STABILISATION ALONG PHILIP KGOSANA DRIVE

The City of Cape Town's Transport Directorate hereby advises the public that stabilisation of the slope along Philip Kgosana Drive, Cape Town will soon start.

Work will take place Monday to Friday (09:00 – 15:00) and Saturday (08:00 – 16:00) from June 2021 for approximately six months, weather permitting and provided there are no unforeseen delays. Night work is not planned but should it be required, such work will take place between 20:00 and 04:00 or in the case of Sundays, all day and night.

Please note that:

- Traffic moving in both directions along Philip Kgosana Drive will be affected
- A section of one lane outbound from Cape Town will be closed to traffic for the duration of the works
- At least one lane will always be open to traffic in both directions
- Flag personnel and signage will regulate traffic
- Work areas will be temporarily demarcated to regulate traffic flow
- The relevant signage displayed over this period must be adhered to

Congestion is to be expected and it is recommended that road users consider alternative routes.

- Werkgebiede tydelik afgebaken sal word om verkeersvloei te reël
- Die padaanwysingsborde gedurende hierdie tydperk nagekom moet word
